40 DAYS FOR LIFE - SIGN UP TO PRAY! As the **February 17**th start date approaches, you'll be able to sign up to pray with us at the 40 Days for Life vigil in Guelph across the street from the Guelph Community Health Centre on Wyndham Street. It's here that the SHORE Centre (formerly called Planned Parenthood Waterloo) has an abortion pill clinic. You can view the prayer calendar and sign up online by visiting www.40daysforlife.com/guelph. You can also sign up by calling our office at 519-836-6311. If it's your first time participating, we'll make sure you are partnered with an experienced prayer volunteer who can answer all of your questions. The 40 Days for Life is from February 17th to March 28th, 2021. We are asking people to commit to a specific hour or hours each week to join us at the vigil. We always plan to have at least two people present at the prayer vigil at all times, with prayer happening every day from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. We will be keeping aware of guidelines around public gatherings, but our hope is that we will be able to safely pray at the abortion pill clinic for the entire 40 days! We hope God will use our witness to reach the women who are considering abortion, and fill them with hope and courage.

The COLDEST NIGHT OF THE YEAR is a fantastically fun, family friendly walk-a-thon that raises money for people experiencing homelessness, hurt, and hunger. This year, Woolwich Community Services is hosting a Covid-safe in-person event with virtual options, with fantastic sponsorship opportunities on Saturday, February 20th. This year it is being offered in a virtual only format. This means we won't be able to gather in person but you can walk anytime in February. There are several maps on the CNOY Elmira page that can give ideas of where to walk! You can register a team of 8-10 people to walk and raise money for Woolwich Community Services. You can register your church or individuals/families can also register their own teams. Each walker is encouraged to raise a minimum of \$150 per adult and \$75 per youth. There is no registration fee for walkers this year. Every walker who raises either \$75 (youth 17 and under) or \$150 (for adults) gets our famous Coldest Night toque.
