

The SHINE A LIGHT PRAYER VIGIL is being held on Thursday, January 28th, 2021 in front of Guelph City Hall from 7 - 8 p.m. Each year, we gather on the anniversary of the 1988 Supreme Court decision that struck down Canada's abortion laws, and left no protection for preborn children at any stage. This event is an hour-long time of outreach and interdenominational prayer. At Shine a Light, we feature an illuminated number display that can't be missed, showing the number of abortions that have happened in Canada since legalization. Our goal is to reach local people who may not realize the enormous loss that abortion legalization has resulted in. Due to COVID-19 gathering restrictions, we ask you to R.S.V.P. in advance so we can plan ahead. It may be necessary for us to host this event in two separate locations with smaller groups. **40 DAYS FOR LIFE – SIGN UP TO PRAY!** As the **February 17**<sup>th</sup> start date approaches, you'll be able to sign up to pray with us at the 40 Days for Life vigil in Guelph across the street from the Guelph Community Health Centre on Wyndham Street. It's here that the SHORE Centre (formerly called Planned Parenthood Waterloo) has an abortion pill clinic. You can view the prayer calendar and sign up online by visiting www.40daysforlife.com/guelph. You can also sign up by calling our office at 519-836-6311. If it's your first time participating, we'll make sure you are partnered with an experienced prayer volunteer who can answer all of your questions. The 40 Days for Life is from February 17<sup>th</sup> to March 28<sup>th</sup>, 2021. We are asking

people to commit to a specific hour or hours each week to join us at the vigil. We always plan to have at least two people present at the prayer vigil at all times, with prayer happening every day from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. We will be keeping aware of guidelines around public gatherings, but our hope is that we will be able to safely pray at the abortion pill clinic for the entire 40 days! We hope God will use our witness to reach the women who are considering abortion, and fill them with hope and courage.
