

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Friday, June 16th is the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. The purpose of devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus is to focus our hearts on receiving and returning His love with gratitude — with all of our heart, soul, and strength — that He may be glorified.

It is also the World Day of Prayer for the Sanctification of Priests. Saint John Paul II began this day in 2002 with the objective of having all Catholic faithful join in prayer for the sanctification of Priests.

Saturday, June 17th is the Memorial of the Immaculate Heart of the Blessed Virgin Mary. This signifies, the great purity and love of the heart of the Blessed Virgin Mary for God. This day falls on the day after the feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus because devotion to these two hearts was promoted together as a means of entering more deeply into the mystery of God's love.

The Bishop as of June 11th is removing the dispensation from the obligation to participate at Sunday Mass, on the Feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi). Bishop Crosby is asking us to return to in-person Masses to fulfill our obligation as Catholics to attend Sunday Mass. Those who are impeded from participating at Sunday Mass because of ill health or care for the sick or some other grave reason, are not bound by the obligation to participate in the Sunday Eucharist.
