

#### **WEEKLY GOSPEL REFLECTION (LK 24:44-53)**

We are told in today's Gospel that when Jesus ascended into heaven, his disciples "returned to Jerusalem with great joy" (Lk 24:53). We wonder how Jesus' definitive separation from his disciples could make them full of joy. The Ascension reveals that to be truly present for someone we love means more than physical closeness. Pope Benedict XVI points out that Jesus' "Ascension" does not mean departure into a distant heaven. That event indicates the continuing closeness of Jesus that the disciples experience so strongly that it becomes a source of lasting joy. Christ ascended into Heaven precisely for this reason, to be closer to us and through us to be closer to others.


