

St. Teresa was a spoiled young woman with an unremarkable prayer life but she soon advanced in prayer, experiencing visions and hearing voices. She succeeded in founding the reformed Discalced Carmelite orders of nuns and friars. She wrote several books and was canonized in 1622 and in 1970 became the first woman to be declared a Doctor of the Church.


