#### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

To honour the message of *Laudato Si'*, the global church recognizes the Season of Creation from September 1<sup>st</sup> - October 4<sup>th</sup> each year. This is a time to renew our commitment as stewards of creation and to respond faithfully to the calls to action in the Pope's encyclical Laudato Si'. In Pope Francis' 2023 Message on the World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation he said, "In Canada, in July 2022, I spoke of the Sea of Galilee where Jesus brought healing and consolation to many people and proclaimed "a revolution of love". Anne, I learned, is also a place of healing, consolation and love, a place that "reminds us that fraternity is genuine if it unites those who are far apart, [and] that the message of unity that heaven sends down to earth does not fear differences, but invites us to fellowship, a communion of differences, in order to start afresh together, because we are all pilgrims on a journey"."
