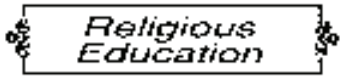

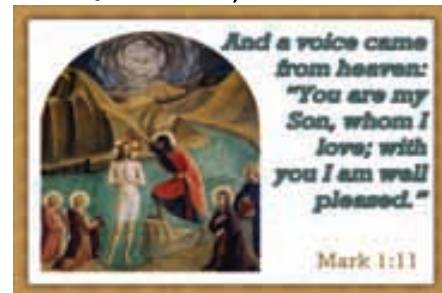
St. Paul the Apostle Feast Day
