FROM THE DESK OF FR. GLASS:

Critical thinking.

We are living in an information-driven society which bombards us indiscriminately with data — all treated as being of equal importance — and which leads to remarkable superficiality in the area of moral discernment. In response, we need to provide an education which teaches critical thinking and encourages the development of mature moral values. — Pope Francis, *Evangelii Gaudium*.

I am still pondering Justin Trudeau's announcement that Catholics are not welcome in the Liberal Party of Canada. How did this country get to the point where this kind of announcement seems normal and reasonable?

We are indeed living in strange times. On the one hand our technological progress is built on scientific analysis and computational logic, yet when it comes to simple moral arithmetic — telling right from wrong — we seem incapable of intelligent thought. Is there even such a thing anymore as moral values? If so, where do they come from?

I know where my moral compass comes from. It comes from the constant teaching of the Catholic Church. It is the teaching of Jesus handed down by the Apostles, tested in the crucible of martyrdom and lived out in the daily lives of the Christian faithful for the past two thousand years. It is the teaching that St. Paul received and passed on to the Churches which he founded. It is the teaching of St. Augustine, St. Thomas Aquinas and St. John Paul II. It is built on the foundation of faith and reason — *fides et ratio*.

The big lie that our secular society has bought into is that faith and reason are opposed. We are told that faith and reason are two completely different and contradictory things. We are told that reason deals with hard scientific facts, and that faith is based on simply wishing it were so.

Faith and reason are not opposed. As grace builds on nature, so faith is reason assisted by grace and raised to a supernatural level. Faith allows us to see beyond the mere facts to the underlying and overarching reality. It is faith that allows us to see the moral dimension of our lives. Faith enables us to make reasonable judgments about the things that really matter.

Science is great for things that can be physically numbered, weighed and measured but science doesn't tell us right from wrong. The modern technology of the 3D ultrasound allows us to the see the baby in his mother's womb—but it doesn't tell us that human life is sacred.

We think we are so smart, but we have become foolish because we have turned our back on the only source of true wisdom. The ultimate foolishness is thinking that God does not exist and that we are not accountable for our actions.

The fools says in his heart, 'There is no God.' The Lord looks down upon the children of men to see if there are any that act wisely, that seek after God.

St. Francis de Sales said, "It is reason alone that makes us men, and yet it is a rare thing to find men truly reasonable." To abandon faith is also to lose hold of reason.
