PASTOR'S DESK

A big "THANK YOU" to all who participated and supported our 2nd Annual Family of Parishes luncheon held this year at St Leopold's.

The dinner was "to die for". The two presentations, the young Croatian dancers and the Spanish dancers were marvelous! Thank you so much for showing unity - the unity that the Holy Spirit urges us to.

Now we are really into "Ordinary Time". The last two weeks we had special solemnities, now we come to the beginning of the "dog days of summer".

In our gospel selection for this weekend taken from St Matthew, Jesus looks with love on the crowds who seem lost and without a leader. So, he calls to himself "leaders" apostles who will be trained by him to lead and to teach and to sanctify. He (Jesus) sees in the crowd a "harvest that is plentiful" but laments that the "laborers are few". He then calls the twelve disciples and begins their formation in his presence. They will hear his words, take note of his rabbinical style. They will witness the miracles and they will enjoy the intimacy of just living in his company and enjoying his love. They are given authority - His authority. In His Name - they cast out demons, heal the sick and raise the dead in body and in spirit.

Do we realize that we to have authority in His Name? That when we pray and offer intercessory prayer for someone we are praying in the Name of Jesus - in His authority. That the Spirit prays in and for us.

That we, in the Name of Jesus, can loosen the bonds of loneliness or poverty with our aid. We can lift the spirit of our neighbor. We too are called by name, chosen - and sent out.

We are entering our school graduation time of year. Let us pray for all of our Grade 8 and Grade 12 graduates and pray that they have a summer and happy summer and as they move on to Grade 9 or to college, university or the work force they may still find a welcoming home with us in the parish.
