

#### INDIGENOUS RECONCILIATION FUND

In the early part of 2022, the Canadian Bishops announced a \$ 30 million fundraising initiative to assist the important work of healing and reconciliation with our indigenous peoples. Hamilton Diocese has made a firm commitment of \$ 4 million in support of this fund. These monies will be gathered over several years. Support will be given to a variety of projects, in and outside of the Diocese, which Indigenous leaders have had a major role in identifying. It was desired that the faithful in the Diocese should have the opportunity to participate in the fundraising. Thank you for your generosity last year, when our parish contributed \$ 5,525 of the Diocesan total of over \$ 170,000. It is now time for the second year's collection (of five in total). The Special Collection envelope inserted in last weekend's bulletin (extras available in the entranceway) can be used for this purpose, in the usual manner. Your contribution will be warmly welcomed over the next few weeks. Thank you for being part of this graced work of healing. Please note that all contributions made will add to the \$ 4 million dollars which the Diocese has already firmly committed. Bishop Crosby's letter, also inserted in that bulletin and available now in the entranceway, gives additional details and references.
