

Each year we are assigned a Missionary who comes to give us a concrete opportunity to collaborate with the Pontifical Mission Societies in supporting the Missionary activity of our Next weekend, we will welcome Sister Lisa Valentini, MSC, a Missionary Sister of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus - from Reading, Pennsylvania. The MSC Sisters were founded by the MSC Fathers and Brothers (who have a Province in Quebec) over 100 years ago - and presently have 676 Sisters working in 21 countries throughout the world. That mission work includes a very large program of Religious Education, a food pantry and a homeless shelter for elderly women. Sister Lisa has been a Missionary for more than 35 years and will be sharing with us about her experiences in Peru, Mexico, Haiti and the Dominican Republic -- and she will tell us stories of her Sisters around the world.
