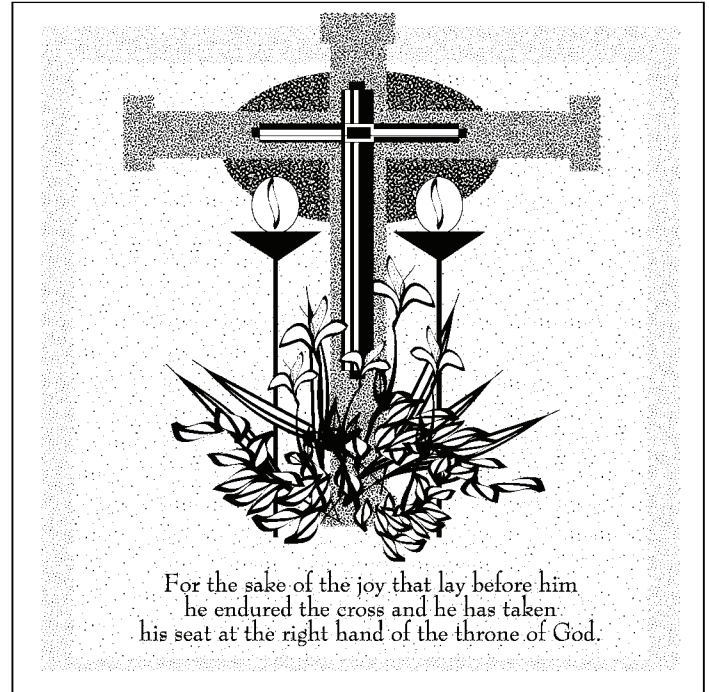

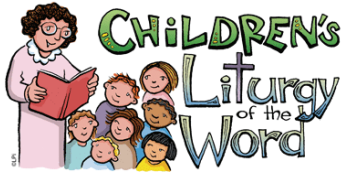
Do you know someone who might be interested in learning more about the Catholic faith?
