

SYNOD 2021 – 2023 "I'M GOING TO SHARE MY VOICE.....WILL YOU SHARE YOURS?"





The process for the next Synod of Bishops has begun, leading to the gathering in Rome in October 2023. The Theme of

the Synod is: *For a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation, and Mission.* For the first time, the meeting will be the culmination of a "three-year path" involving all of the People of God at every level of the Church. This "path" is a process rather than an event.

The first phase (October 2021 to April 2022) has begun under the leadership of the Bishop in each Diocese. This stage is conceived as a broad consultation with the People of God in each Diocese. *Hamilton Diocese is active in this!*
