FEAST OF THE PRESENTATION OF THE LORD Candlemas Day, February 2nd

The 40th day after Christmas marks the celebration of the occasion when Mary and Joseph brought the child Jesus to the Temple to present him as an offering to God, in accordance with ancient Jewish tradition. The old prophet, Simeon, saw in this child the fulfillment of the Messianic longing of the people of Israel, and praised God for the blessing. In part because of Simeon's declaration that this child would be "the light of revelation to the nations", a tradition arose to celebrate this day as a mid-winter Feast of Light, with candles blessed and carried in processions. As this great Feast falls on Sunday this year, we are blessing Candlemas Day candles at all Masses today and making them available in the narthex for your use at home. There are 2 candles per box, suggested donation is \$5.00.


FEAST OF ST. BLAISE, February 3rd

Saint Blaise was a bishop in Armenia during the fourth century. He is said to have healed a boy who nearly died because of a fishbone stuck in his throat. Since the 8th century, St. Blaise has been venerated as the patron of those who suffer from diseases of the throat. The blessing of throats is celebrated by touching the throat of each person with two candles joined together in the form of a cross as we pray in a special way for protection from afflictions of the throat and other illnesses. This year since Feb. 3rd falls on Monday, the **Blessing of Throats** will be conferred on all who wish to receive this blessing at the end of **8 a.m. Mass on Tuesday, Feb. 4**th.
