Special Mass – Saturday, Feb. 2nd @ 9:00 a.m. To honour Feast Days for Presentation of the Lord and St. Blaise

As the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord, and the Feast of St. Blaise fall on Saturday and Sunday respectively this year, we will have one Mass on Sat. Feb. 2nd at 9:00 a.m. to honour both. We shall bless Candlemas Day candles at this mass and make them available in the church narthex for your use at home. There are two candles in a box. Suggested donation is \$5.00 per box.

At the end of this Mass, the Blessing of Throats will be conferred on all who wish to receive this blessing.

FEAST OF THE PRESENTATION OF THE LORD Candlemas Day

The 40th day after Christmas marks the celebration of the occasion when Mary and Joseph brought the child Jesus to the Temple to present him as an offering to God, in accordance with ancient Jewish tradition. The old prophet, Simeon, saw in this child the fulfillment of the Messianic longing of the people of Israel, and praised God for the blessing. In part because of Simeon's declaration that this child would be "the light of revelation to the nations", a tradition arose to celebrate this day as a mid-winter Feast of Light, with candles blessed and carried in processions.


FEAST OF ST. BLAISE

Saint Blaise was a bishop in Armenia during the fourth century. He is said to have healed a boy who nearly died because of a fishbone stuck in his throat. Since the eighth century, St. Blaise has been venerated as the patron of those who suffer from diseases of the throat. The blessing of throats is celebrated this day by touching the throat of each person with two candles joined together in the form of a cross as we pray in a special way for protection from afflictions of the throat and from other illnesses.


