

OUR GIFTS TO GOD

We sincerely thank you for your continued spiritual and financial support of Holy Rosary Parish. This has been particularly appreciated ever since the very challenging years of the pandemic. Here are the fruits of the major categories of collections over these past weeks (each Sunday figure includes weekly PAD average of \$ 1,600):

Sunday, December 17: \$7,472

Sunday, December 24: \$5,349

Christmas: \$24,576 (donations for flowers included)

Sunday, December 31: \$5,932

New Year's: \$ 2,422

Saint Vincent de Paul: \$ 1,150 (SSVDP Total for 2023 is approximately \$ 37,000, which is an \$ 8,000 increase over both 2022 and 2021---note that this is only the total given through the parish---it also includes \$ 5,000 handed over to SSVDP from the Capital Campaign; but it does not include donations made directly to SSVDP, only those given through the parish.)

In February, as always, your Parish Finance Council will review the final 2023 figures (including Capital Campaign funds expenditures), and will then prepare a proper report to be given to the parish in March.
