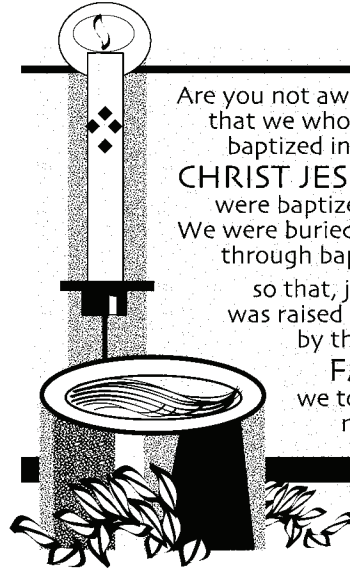
We welcome **Jack Joseph Hayward, Millie Pearl Duggan, and Douglas Charles Nicholson.** In the celebration of the
