

PASTORAL REFERENCE LETTERS

Pastors receive many requests for Pastoral Reference Letters from people seeking teaching positions within the Catholic school system. I am happy to provide letters for those who live within our parish boundaries, are members of Holy Rosary Parish, attend Mass regularly, participate in the sacramental and pastoral life of the Church community, and are in good canonical standing within the Church. When seeking an appointment for a pastoral reference, I ask that all candidates do the following before booking an appointment:

- Please fill out the candidate portion of the application forms for the Board(s) for which you hope to find employment and the Faith Reference Portfolio prior to the pastoral reference interview with me. This information helps me to compose a more complete reference. The application forms typically include a Pastoral Reference Form to be filled out by the pastor. In many cases I often include a letter.
- Please bring a recent copy of your baptismal certificate and, if married, a copy of your marriage certificate to the interview.
- Please be aware that all pastoral references are positive but honest expressions of the pastor's assessment of the candidate's current level of faith and involvement in the parish's life. This assessment is based on personal knowledge and the candidate's responses in the interview.
- Please be aware that it may take a few weeks to arrange an appointment and Letters are usually completed and ready for pickup by the candidate after Mass on the weekend.
