

Arrangements have been made for a

special treat on the day marking the 75th anniversary of the very day on which then-Father Bernard Harrigan called Holy Rosary Parish into being with its first Mass. On Wednesday, July 6th (it was a Sunday in 1947!), we will celebrate Mass in the Chapel at the back of Holy Sepulchre Cemetery, at 10:00 A.M. (no 8:00 A.M. Mass in our church that day). That was the site of Mass for the parish for its first four years, until the school was built in 1951. Memorabilia will be on site.
