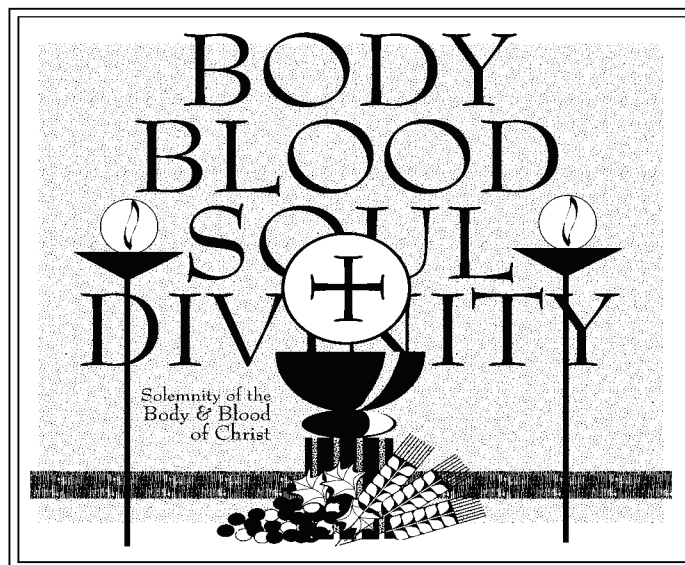

SPECIAL MASS ON HOLY ROSARY PARISH'S 75TH BIRTHDAY, WEDNESDAY, JULY 6TH, 2022!



Arrangements have been made for a special treat on the day marking the 75th anniversary of the very day on which then-Father Bernard Harrigan called Holy Rosary Parish into being with its first Mass. On Wednesday, July 6th (it was a Sunday in 1947!), we will celebrate Mass in the Chapel at the back of Holy Sepulchre Cemetery, at 10:00 A.M. (no 8:00 A.M. Mass in our church that day). That was the site of Mass for the parish for its first four years, until the school was built in 1951. Memorabilia will be on site. Opportunity for visiting the nearby graves of past Bishops and Pastors. Come out that day, to breathe in our history and our roots!

KAIROS BLANKET EXERCISE (ON ZOOM)

The KAIROS Blanket Exercise is a powerful interactive and experiential teaching tool that explores the historic and contemporary relationship between Indigenous and non-Indigenous peoples in the land we now know as Canada. Hosted on the Zoom platform, the virtual KBE incorporates new interactive and engaging elements that visually and emotionally demonstrate the history of Indigenous peoples in Canada through colonization to present times. It is a live, participatory experience, not a webinar or lecture. Our facilitation teams support participants via online features and special measures, and host virtual talking circles for the second half of the exercise. June 28th, 6 – 9 P.M.
