

# SPECIAL MASS ON HOLY ROSARY PARISH'S 75<sup>TH</sup> BIRTHDAY, WEDNESDAY, JULY 6<sup>TH</sup>, 2022!



Arrangements have been made for a special treat on the day marking the



75<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the very day on which then-Father Bernard Harrigan called Holy Rosary Parish into being with its first Mass. On Wednesday, July 6<sup>th</sup> (it was a Sunday in 1947!), we will celebrate Mass in the Chapel at the back of Holy Sepulchre Cemetery, at 10:00 A.M. (no 8:00 A.M. Mass in our church that day). That was the site of Mass for the parish for its first four years, until the school was built in 1951. Memorabilia will be on site. Opportunity for visiting the nearby graves of past Bishops and Pastors. Come out that day, to breathe in our history and our roots!
