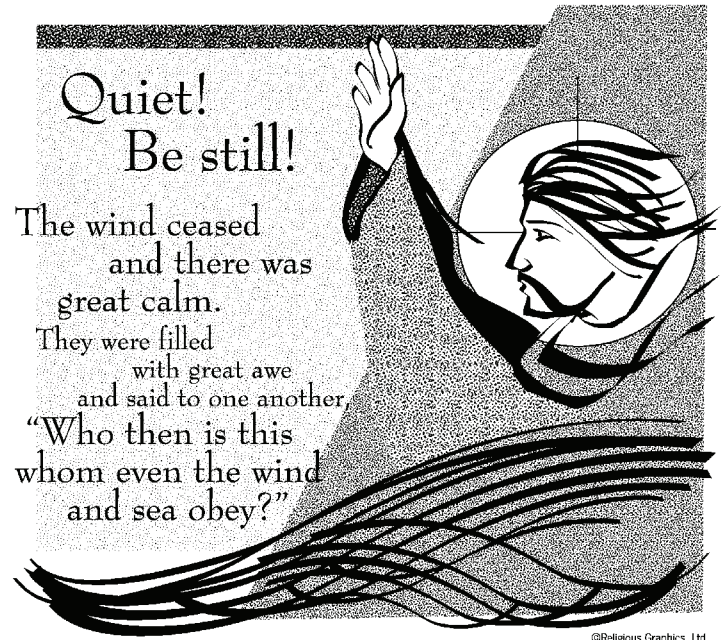
**SUMMER MASS SCHEDULE
