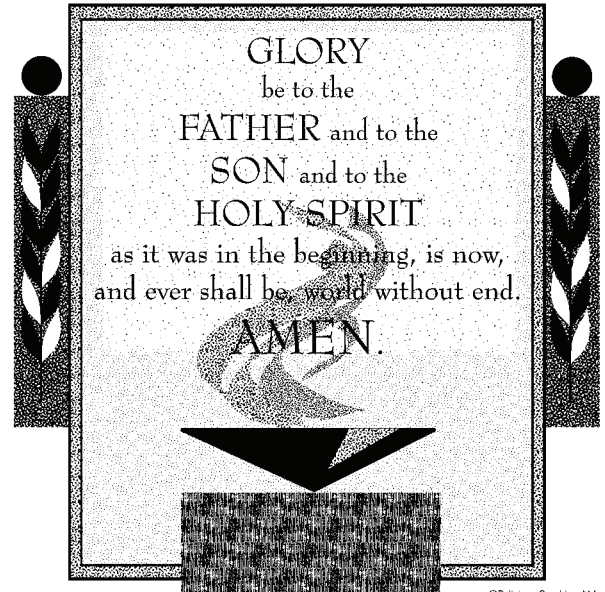

IN CASE YOU MISSED IT.....

Last weekend, Pentecost Sunday, a Letter from Bishop Crosby was read at all Masses in all parishes in the Diocese. By this Letter, he announced the end of the dispensation from attending Sunday Mass, a concession which had been in place since the pandemic began in March, 2020. All Catholics who are able, whose health and situation allows, are now to resume attending Mass in person, if they have not already done so. While we still have the livestreamed Mass on our website, it does not fulfill the Sunday obligation for those who can be at Mass in person instead.
