The Grade 8 students of Holy Rosary School are presenting a dramatization of the Stations of the Cross in the school gym, on which they have been working very hard. Presentations


are on <u>Holy Thursday, March 28th, 10:30 A.M., and 1:30 P.M.</u> All are welcome to attend.
