12 HOURS OF PRAYER FOR PALLIATIVE CARE



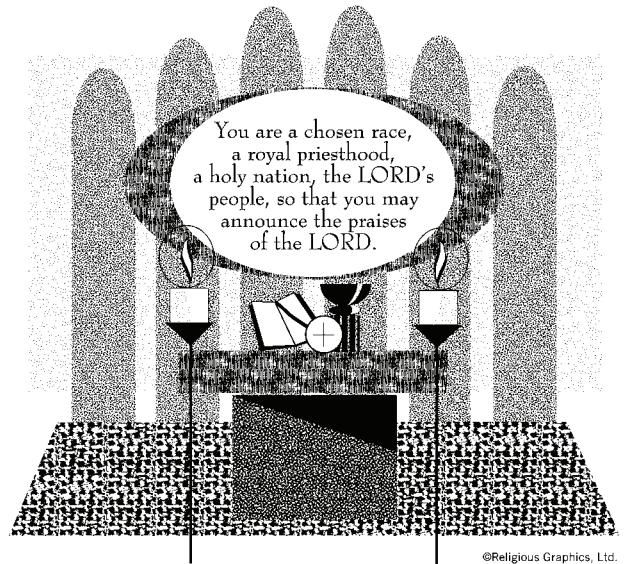
