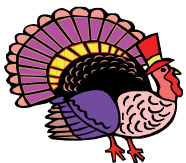
**SUNDAY MISSALS ON SALE NOW**

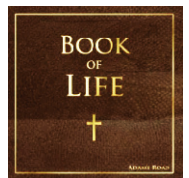
