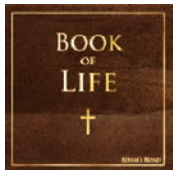
## ANNUAL MEMORIAL MASS

## BOOK OF LIFE AND REMEMBRANCE



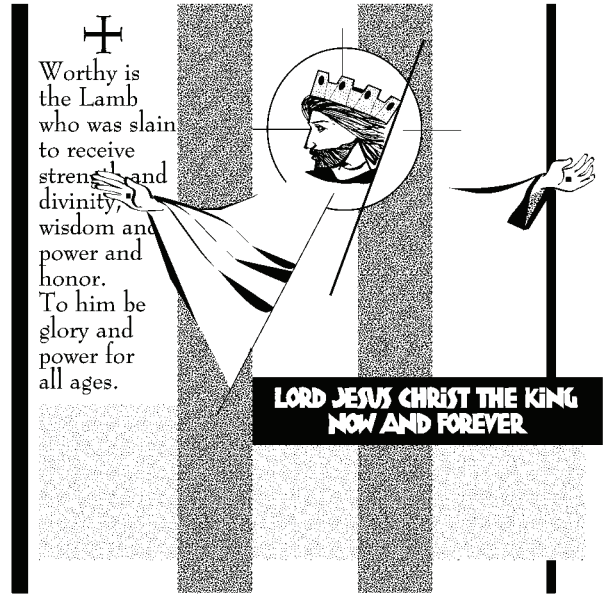
