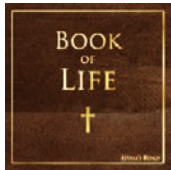

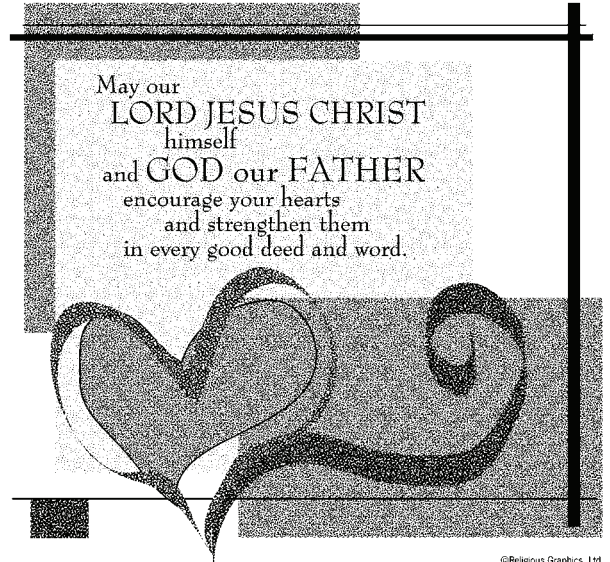
COPING WITH THE HOLIDAYS

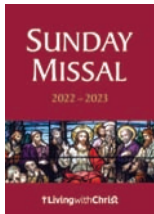
