

FEAST OF OUR LADY OF THE MOST HOLY ROSARY, SATURDAY, OCTOBER 7TH

We rejoice in the annual celebration of our parish and school Feast Day, which will be recognized at all Masses this coming weekend. At one time, this Feast was known as "Our Lady of Victory", to honour a decisive victory of Christian forces at Lepanto in 1571. The Pope had called for all of Europe to pray the Rosary for Our Lady's intervention in the crisis, and the creation of the Feast Day was an offering of thanks for blessings received.

Nowadays, we celebrate the Feast to call to mind the powerful gift of the Rosary, and the many spiritual benefits to be obtained by entering into this meditative prayer. Pope Saint John Paul II called the Rosary a kind of "school", where Our Blessed Mother teaches us how to encounter the mystery of the Lord's infinite love for her and for us all.

MARRIAGE SUPPORT
