PRAYING THE LITURGY OF THE HOURS (Divine Office)



SECOND VATICAN COUNCIL: 60TH ANNIVERSARY

Last Tuesday, October 11th, marked the 60th Anniversary of the Opening of "Vatican II", the Ecumenical Council called by Pope Saint John XXIII, and completed in 1965, after four years of sessions, under Pope Saint Paul VI. This pivotal event in the life and history of the Church is still being studied and implemented to this day, not without enduring controversies. Pope Francis offered Mass last Tuesday in Saint Peter's Basilica to mark the anniversary, and especially to honour John XXIII for his vision.

Opening the Council in 1962, John XXIII stated: "The Catholic Church, as she raises the torch of religious truth through this Ecumenical Council, wishes to show herself a most loving mother of all, benign, patient, and moved with mercy and goodness towards the children separated from her....The Church does not offer to the people of our time riches that perish...but she imparts the goods of heavenly grace....She extends everywhere the bounds of Christian charity...."
