

CONGRATULATIONS TO OUR MUSIC DIRECTOR!


This weekend, our parish Director of Liturgical Music, Dr. William Renwick, has received an Honorary Award as a Fellow of the Royal School of Church Music. William would have travelled to England to receive the designation, but the entire ceremony was instead conducted virtually.
