A worthy personal disposition is required, includina Communion. OUR **MONTHLY** Confession and ADORATION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT FOR **NOVEMBER WILL BE ON ALL SOULS' DAY, FROM 8:30** A.M. TO 12;00 NOON.



We invite our parishioners and visitors to sign the names of all relatives and friends, who have died, into the **BOOK OF LIFE**. The book will be at the front of the Church, near the Baptismal Font and the Easter Candle; it will remain there during the


