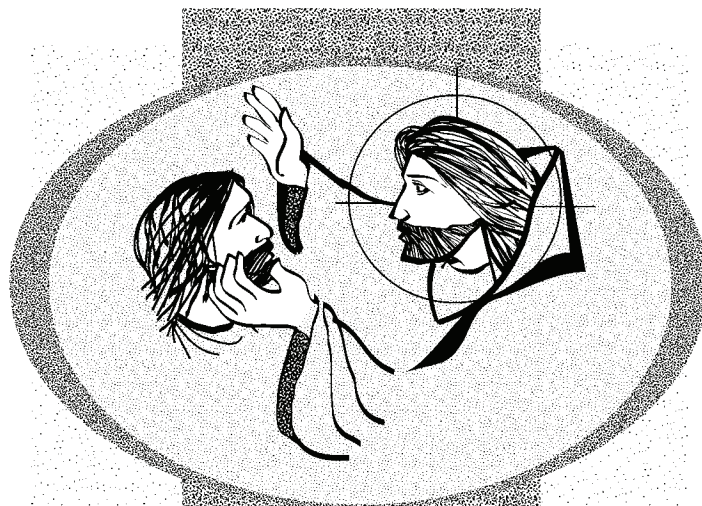
BAPTISMS – WELCOME!
