CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE WORD

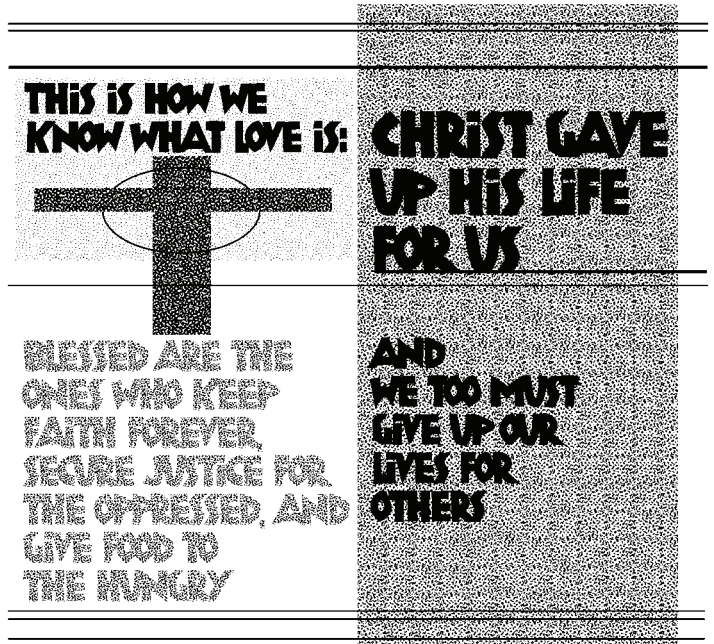


This special ministry has now resumed at the 9:00 a.m. Mass. It is for school-aged children who have not yet made their First Communion. They go to the
