**MASS WITH ANOINTING OF THE SICK at Holy Rosary Church**

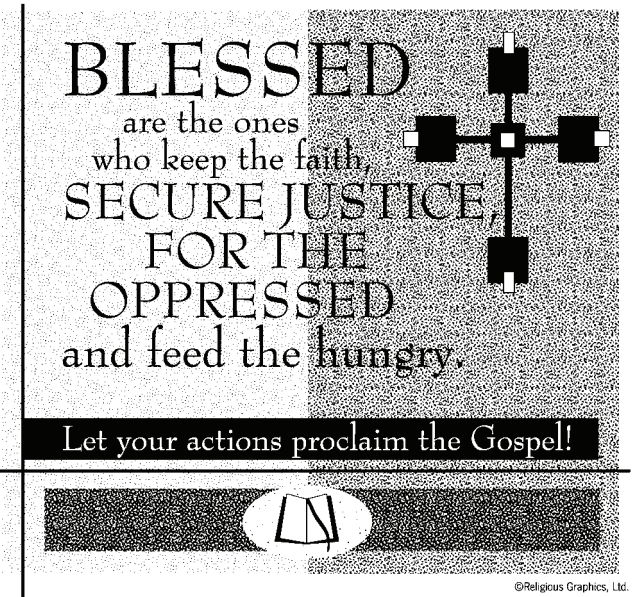
