

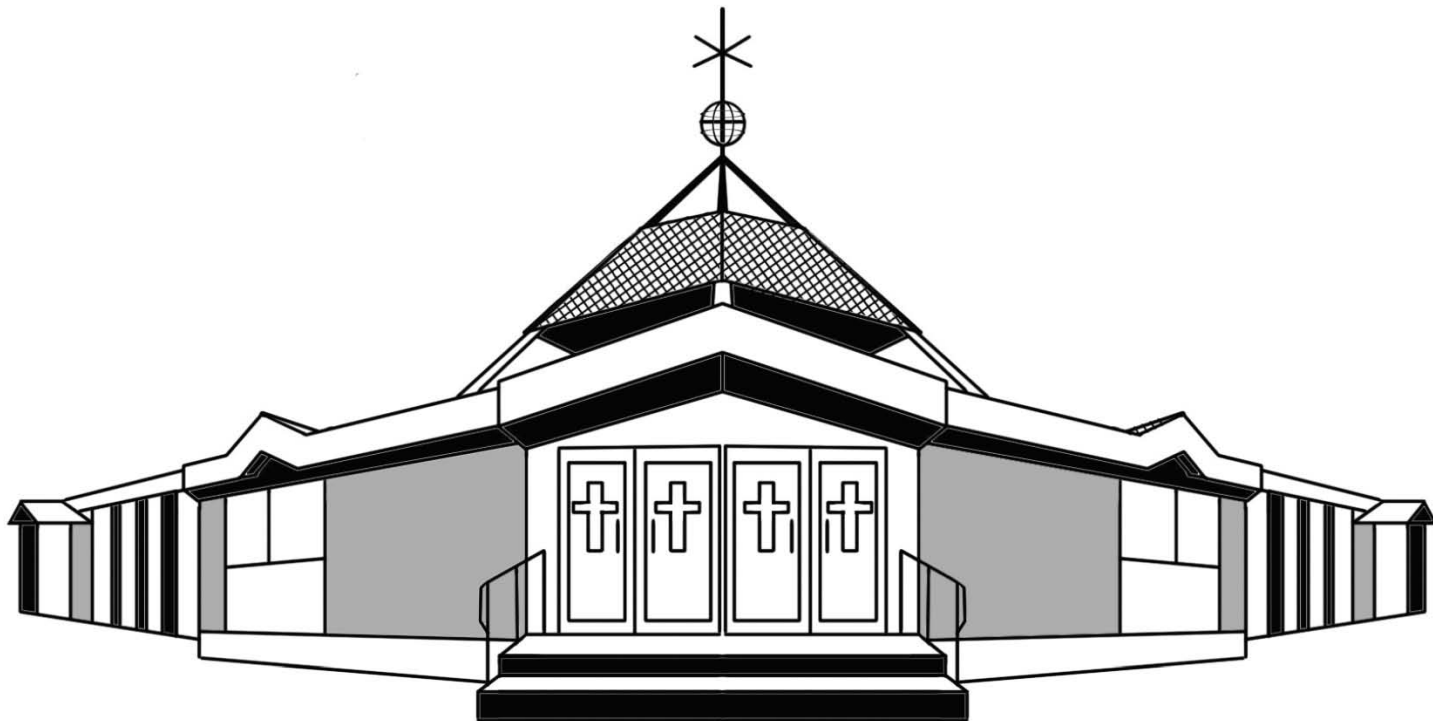

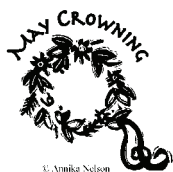

Xenoestrogens are industrially made compounds such as PCB, BPA & Phthalates & are found in plastics & plastic wrap. They mimic or interfere with estrogen in our bodies & form a subset of a broader group of chemicals known as endocrine disruptors that go directly to the tissues bi-passing the liver for detoxification. They are implicated in medical problems such as breast cancer & reproductive function in males & females. Avoid cling wrap & replace wrap on meats & other foods before freezing or refrigerating. Never heat food with plastic in microwave, use glass instead. Avoid Teflon – use cast iron. Minimize use of tin cans. Don't drink from Styrofoam cups or containers. – M Cordeiro for The Green Team
