On October 15, 2012, Canada Post issued a **new religious stamp for the Christmas season** depicting the Madonna and Child in stained glass, from one of the more than 150-year-old stained glass windows at the Cathedral of St. Mary of the Immaculate Conception in Kingston, Ontario. The creation of coloured glass by artisans was adopted by Christian churches of the 4<sup>th</sup>

and 5<sup>th</sup> centuries. It was used most extensively in the Middle Ages as a means of communicating bible stories to a mostly illiterate population. It continues today to tell the stories for adults and for children.

If you are sending Christmas greetings to your friends, remember that "Jesus is the reason for the season." Purchase cards that celebrate the Christian message. Share the joy of knowing Christ with others. Use the nativity Christmas stamps on all your mail during the Christmas season. Purchase enough stamps that you can use them all year long as they are only for sale at this time of year. If they are sold out, ask when the new shipment comes in and ask them to hold several books for you. Celebrate being a follower of Jesus all the time!
