#### **April is Autism Acceptance Month**

Autism spectrum disorder (ASD) refers to a broad range of conditions characterized by challenges with social skills, repetitive behaviours, speech, and nonverbal communication. Autism looks different for everyone, each person having a distinct set of strengths and challenges. Some autistic people can speak, while others are nonverbal or minimally verbal and communicate in other ways. Some have intellectual disabilities, while some do not. Some require significant support in their daily lives, while others need less, and others live entirely independently. Anybody can be autistic, regardless of sex, age, race, or ethnicity, however, Centers for Disease Control and Prevention research shows that boys get diagnosed with autism four times more often than girls. Autism is a lifelong condition, and an autistic person's needs, strengths and challenges may change over time. 
