The gospel for the 17<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary time reminds us of Jesus feeding the crowd of 5000 with just a few pieces of bread and fish. The multiplication of the loaves and fish is one of the most famous narratives in the bible, and points us to many realities of the faith. The first, a foreshadowing of Eucharist, that Jesus continues to multiply his body and blood throughout all generations. A second lesson - Jesus always gives in great abundance. He doesn't just give 'enough', but as we hear from the gospel several baskets of left over food were collected. When we receive our Lord in the Eucharist, let's never forget that he is giving us his very self each time we receive Holy Communion. He also never fails to give us in abundance, more than we can every realize or imagine!
