SACRAMENTAL INFORMATION

Baptism - Infants and young children of parishioners are baptized on Sunday afternoons, except during the Season of Lent. Adults requesting baptism, or the other sacraments of initiation should inquire about the RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults). Contact the Parish Office for more information.

Marriage - Weddings for parishioners are generally celebrated on Saturday afternoons. Kindly contact the Pastor a minimum of one year before the desired date of marriage. Preparation is provided in the Parish.

Arrangements can be made for the *Sacrament of the Sick* and for *Holy Communion*. Irritable Bowel Syndrome Awareness

Irritable bowel syndrome (IBS) is a chronic functional bowel disorder characterized by symptoms of abdominal pain and altered bowel habits (constipation and diarrhea), in the absence of structural or biochemical abnormalities that are detectable with the current routine diagnostic tools. According to the Gastrointestinal Society: 13-20% of Canadians are living with IBS; only 40% of them will seek medical help; it is more common in women, but still affects many men; people of all ages have IBS, from young children to the elderly; the primary symptoms are abdominal pain, bloating, and constipation and/or diarrhea; symptoms can come and go, so you might feel well for a while only to get symptoms again. The underlying cause of IBS is still unclear and, as there are no diagnostic disease markers for IBS, guidelines recommend physicians make a positive diagnosis using criteria that are based on the person's symptoms. Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

There is sometimes confusion over what the Sacrament of the Sick is. Anyone experiencing serious illness may receive the sacrament, not just those who are close to death. In fact, it is preferable to receive the sacrament early in an illness when the person in ill health can benefit from the healing graces available as they battle their sickness. It is also the case that one can receive the Sacrament more than once during a time of serious illness, so there is no need to wait until the 'last minute' to call the priest. 'Last Rites', as the sacrament is often referred to, is actually the receiving of three sacraments if the person is able - Reconciliation, Anointing of the Sick, and Holy Communion. If you or a loved one have been diagnosed with a serious illness, contact the office to set up a time to receive the sacrament. If it is a hospital emergency (at any hospital, not just Georgetown), the nurses will have the contact information of local on-call priests which you can request.
