Sunday Reflection:

Jesus tells us "unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you have no life in you".

The miracle of the multiplication of the loaves that we heard recently, and this long passage we read over four Sundays, is clearly Eucharistic. John's Gospel was the last one written and it has the most developed theology of the four gospels. His community had a lot of time to ponder the meaning of the events of Jesus Christ's life and ministry. John and his community had a very profound regard for the miracle of the Eucharist.

John's Gospel was written to get the reader or hearer to come to a decision. Having heard the testimony, she or he must confront the reality that Jesus is the Son of God and either accept or reject that truth. Accepting or rejecting Jesus then conditions all of the rest of our behaviour. Either you accept Jesus Christ and already experience the life of God, or reject him and currently experience spiritual death, while being alive in the world. An important part of accepting Jesus Christ means appreciating what the Eucharist means for us.
