Word from the Pastor

Jesus' ministry was under siege from powerful and influential religious authorities. He was challenged and misunderstood and even to his disciples he must have seemed to be going nowhere. Hence the parable of the mustard seed. It speaks of hope and patient courage. What is small and seemingly insignificant can bring a fruitful outcome. That's the way God works; have we not noticed?

The mustard seed has small beginnings, but with a large destiny. At times we may be involved in seeming small works and projects, but the results can surprise us. Proof of the surprise awaits us when we do what each day asks of us. Our efforts may seem small, but the parable suggests we not eliminate the possibility of surprise for our efforts on behalf of the kingdom. Let's take seriously the promise God makes us through the prophet Ezekiel. God will do for us what God did for our Jewish ancestors: build again from the small and weak and provide shelter for the lost and wandering. God will, "lift high the lowly tree." We are not talking about becoming high and mighty, or a political force. But from our diminished status and fragile faith, God can raise up prophetic people, put down human values and raise up the lowly. Our prayer, in light of Ezekiel's promise: "We are a wounded people, small and fragile, O God. But we are your people. Be our faithful God, plant a shoot of healing and renewal among us so all will be safe and fruitful in our community."
