Word from the Pastor

We can see why our first reading was chosen today. Job 38.1. God speaks to Job “out of the storm.” It is a theophany, a manifestation of God’s power and presence. (It suggests what is happening in the gospel as well.) At this point in the story of Job each of his “comforters” has spoken and Job has answered them. But the problem raised by Job’s afflictions remains: why do humans suffer? It is now God’s turn to speak “out of the storm.” God’s answer simply states God’s transcendence over humans and power over nature. God is sovereign over everything. In today’s passage that rule is over the sea and prepares us to hear the gospel when Jesus manifests his authority over the storm. After hearing the gospel, the question raised by the awe-filled disciples is ours as well, “Who then is this whom even wind and sea obey?”

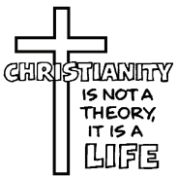
Thank you, Finance Council members, for the update on Parish Finances this weekend and for your loyal support of the Parish.
