In the Gospel we hear Jesus say, "what God has joined together, let no-one separate." (Mk 10.9) As Christians, we understand that marriage is much more than a special contract, it is a covenant and when it is celebrated between two baptized Christians it is raised to the dignity of a sacrament. As Catholic Christians we know that a problem with society's view of marriage today is that it sees marriage as merely a contract between two, consenting adults. It fails to grasp its God-given dignity as a sacred union between man and woman that invites us into the reality of God's love for the human person. Marriage dignifies the difference of the sexes and transforms human relations into a reflection for God's love and self-gift to us.
