Holy Thursday is the day on which Christ celebrated the Last Supper with His disciples, four days after His triumphal entry in Jerusalem on Palm Sunday. <p><u>Good Friday, April 19th, 2019</u> Children's Service 11:00 am & Passion Service 3:00 pm There are three parts to the liturgy of the day: 1) The Liturgy of the Word; 2) The Veneration of the Cross; and 3) The Rite of Holy Communion with hosts that were consecrated on Holy Thursday. Stations of the Cross 6:30 pm (Presented by L'Arche Sudbury) Mass is not celebrated on this day or before the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday. Good Friday is a universal day of fasting—without causing harm to your health— and abstinence from meat. The law of abstinence from meat binds those who are 14 and older; the law of fasting binds those from 18 to 59 years of age. The faithful are encouraged to continue this solemn fast throughout Holy Saturday as they remain at the tomb of the Lord, meditating on his suffering, death and descent to the dead.</p>	 <p>Fr. <p><u>The Easter Vigil Saturday, April 20th, 2019 - 8:00 pm. (NO 5:00 pm today)</u> The Easter Vigil has four parts: 1. The Service of Light; 2. The Liturgy of the Word; 3. The Liturgy of Baptism; and 4. The Liturgy of the Eucharist. At the Easter Vigil we bless the Easter water—the water that will be used for baptisms. St. Augustine said that the Easter Vigil, the night when Jesus Christ was raised from the dead, is to be considered the “mother of all vigils”.</p>	 <p>Fr. Brendan Doherty</p>
<p><u>Easter Sunday, April 21st, 2019 — 10:15 am</u> Jesus Christ is Risen Today— Alleluia! At the Mass we will invite all the faithful to renew the profession of their baptismal faith.
