The Sacrament of Confirmation will be celebrated at Christ the King on **Wednesday, June 5, 2024 at 7:00 pm.**



Students who are in Grade 7 are eligible to receive this sacrament. Older students and young adults who may have missed an earlier reception of this Sacrament are welcome to participate at this time. Baptismal Certificates are required for all candidates.

After Jesus had died and risen, He met His Apostles a number of times. He told them to go out and tell the world about what had happened.

Pray with our children for the grace to share the Good News with others.

Reflection: God's self-communication is not a human initiative. He freely makes Himself known. God is more than a topic to be studied. Our understanding of God demands attentive personal encounters. Have you asked yourself why the Resurrection was not narrated as appearing to the to the opponents of life or the proponents of death? Say for example, Pontius Pilate or the Roman Soldiers? The Resurrection appearances were directed to the faithful, to address their wavering faith. Faith presupposes personal freedom, to opt-in without compulsion. The truth of Faith is proposed, not imposed.

In allowing the author of life to taste death, it is now always possible to convert tragedy to triumph. We are triumphant when we join our sufferings to that of our saviour, so as to rise with Him. Hence, by resurrection, death was reversed and converted to life. The Crucifixion reminds us that humanity was at its worst point, divinity was at its best point. At the Cross, the lowest of evil was opposed by the highest point of good. 'God's Word, Daily Reflections 2024'
