Pray with our children for the grace to share the Good News with others.

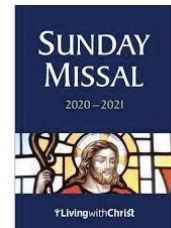

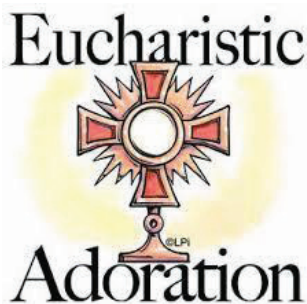

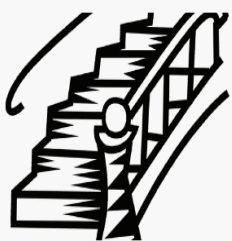


Every Wednesday before mass we will be having Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and saying the Rosary.

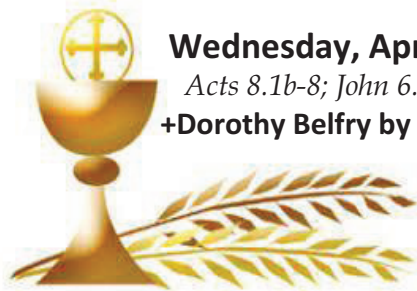
