Yet the people recognised him as "the prophet Jesus, from Nazareth of Galilee". This was part of His large plan to empty Himself, as St. Paul says, "though He was in the Form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men. And being found in human form, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even on a cross." (Phil 2:6-8) Yet this is a triumphant entry because humility is strength in the eyes of God.

Attendance at the Good Friday Liturgy of the Lord's Passion and Death has been in decline in many parts of our country; but we can change this! If we want to really "get" Easter, we need Good Friday. 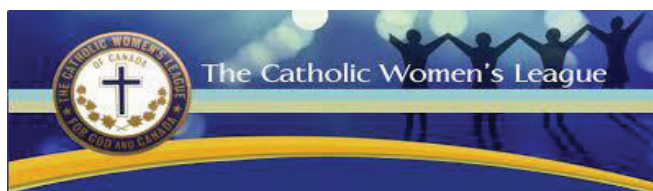
