CANONIZATION OF BLESSED JOHN PAUL II AND BLESSED JOHN XXIII ... On April 27, 2014,

Pope Francis will declare his two predecessors Saints. Recognizing that Blessed John XXIII and John Paul II have widespread reputations for holiness and that after years of studying their lives and actions have proven their exceptional virtue. Both Popes were also responsible for great political and cultural transformation. Blessed John Paul II served as Pope from 1978 to 2005 and was beatified by Pope Benedict XVI on Divine Mercy Sunday, May 1, 2011. He is known as one of the most influential leaders of the 20th century. Blessed John XXIII, known particularly for convoking the Second Vatican Council, was Pope from 1958 to 1963; Blessed John Paul II beatified him in 2000.



Msgr. Farrell was a retired priest in our Diocese who died on April 10, 2014. He was ordained to the priesthood in 1954 and retired in 2001. Msgr. SAINTS' CORNER

BLESSED MARIE-ANNE BLONDIN... Sister Marie-Anne was born in what is now a suburb of Montreal in 1809. She learned how to read and write while working as a domestic for nuns. By 1850, with the permission of Bishop Bourget, she founded the Congregation of the Sisters of Saint Anne for educating poor boys and girls in non-segregated classrooms. Because of that approach, considered "subversive" at the time by the local clergy, she endured much suffering and sorrow. The Motherhouse and the tomb of Blessed Marie can be visited in Lachine, QC, with its museum, permanent and temporary exhibitions. For more information, visit www.ssacong.org.




