To lead others, be ready to make sacrifices. Remember Ezekiel's prophecy that warns us of abuse of any pastoral office

entrusted to us; the duty of a shepherd is to feed the sheep, and not to feed on the sheep. If you do not exercise the pastoral ministries properly, the Lord may take His flock out of your charge. You must make the followers nurture a good relationship with God. As parents, pastor your children well. '*God's Word, Daily Reflections 2024'*


